These are called INDEFINITE PRONOUNS.

Is anyone here?

Everybody recognizes the importance of education.

Nedoločne zaimke, ki se končujejo na **-thing**, uporabljaš v zvezi s **stvarmi, predmeti**, **situacijami** in **dejavnostmi**.

Can I do anything?

Jane said nothing for a moment.

Nedoločne zaimke, ki se končujejo na -one in -body, uporabljaš v zvezi z ljudmi.

Ask anyone.

It was someone like Dan.



Nedoločni zaimki, ki se začnejo s some- in every- se v glavnem uporabljajo v trdilnih povedih.

Now you'll see something.

Everything went according to plan.

Have you seen Frank? Is everything all right?

Nedoločne zaimke z any- uporabljamo predvsem v nikalnih in vprašalnih povedih.

I didn't buy anything. = I bought nothing.


I didn't see anybody \ any one. = I saw nobody \ no one.

I didn't go anywhere. = I went nowhere.

Zaimke z **any-** lahko včasih uporabimo tudi **v trdilnih povedih**, kadar **pomenijo izbiro**: kdorkoli (anybody, anyone), karkoli (anything) in kamorkoli (anywhere).

Anyone can make a mistake like that. (=kdorkoli)

Do anything you want. (=karkoli)
